The Currier Museum of Art is an internationally renowned art museum featuring European and American paintings, decorative arts, photographs and sculpture, including works by Picasso, Monet, O'Keeffe, Wyeth and LeWitt with exhibitions, tours and programs year-round. Our Currier pass provides free general admission for up to two adults (18 years and over) and all youth family members (ages 13 – 17); children 12 years and under are always free. We have two of these passes and they can be used on the same day. During your visit, you may participate in any programs which are offered free with general admission (some programs *may* require a materials fees).

The Mariposa Museum brings the rich diversity of world cultures to New England. Through education programs, exhibits, performances and workshops, they provide a unique place for children, seniors and adults to celebrate our common humanity. Our pass admits one library member and two children.



CANTERBURY
Shaker Village

Canterbury Shaker Village offers visitors a variety of entertaining, educational and engaging experiences in one of the most picturesque settings in northern New England. Our pass provides free admission for a family of up to two adults and two children.

Additional family members are admitted for half price, \$8.50 for adults and \$5.50 for children. (Regular admission is \$19 for adults and \$9 for children ages 6-17). The pass is valid for one specific day, and we have only one pass per day. During your visit, you may participate in any programs and activities that are offered free with general admission.

The New Hampshire Division of Parks and Recreation's Library Pass entitles admission to all day-use parks for two adults and up to four dependents. It is not valid at Hampton Beach State Park-South Beach, Wallis Sands State Park, Cannon Mountain Aerial Tramway, or the Flume Gorge and it is not valid for use at the metered parking on the seacoast or for camping. Most of the parks are only open from Memorial Day weekend through Columbus Day weekend although Monadnock State Park is open year-round so you can use the pass at Monadnock through December 31st. We have one pass for each day of the week that you can borrow and then return for the next person(s).



SEACOAST

The Seacoast Science Center is the perfect place to explore, discover, and connect with nature—especially the salty kind. Our library has two passes per day for two adults and four children....BUT upon arrival at the door, you must pay 50% of admission. So these passes are really a 50% discount.
