TOWN OF FRANCESTOWN PARKING ORDINANCE

General Parking:

It shall be unlawful for the owner of any vehicle or any person having custody or control of any vehicle to park or permit the same to be parked in the following locations in the Town of Francestown. Vehicles found parked in violation of the provisions of these regulations may be moved by or under the direction of Francestown Police officers or their designee at the sole expense of the owner of said vehicle.

- A. Within an intersection
- B. Upon any sidewalk
- C. Upon any crosswalk
- D. Upon a road where parking is permitted unless both wheels on the passenger side of the vehicle are within twelve (12) inches of the curb or the edge of the road, except those roads designated as one way. On one-way roads, a vehicle shall be parked parallel to the curb or the edge of the road in the direction of authorized traffic movement with its passenger-side wheels within twelve (12) inches of the curb on the edge of the road or its driver-side wheels within twelve (12) inches of the curb or the edge of the road
- E. Upon any road where the parking of vehicles will not leave a clear and unobstructed lane of at least ten (10) feet wide for passing traffic
- F. Upon any road within twenty (20) feet of a fire hydrant
- G. Upon or in front of any private road or driveway without property owners approval
- H. Upon any road within fifteen (15) feet of an intersecting road
- I. Alongside or opposite any road construction when such stopping, standing, or parking would obstruct traffic
- J. Handicapped parking areas, except by permit

Any person found in violation of these provisions will be subject to a fine not to exceed \$50.00 U. S. for each violation.

Winter Parking:

It shall be unlawful for the owner of any vehicle or any person having custody or control of any vehicle to park or permit the same to be parked on any public way from November 1 to April 1 of each year or in any manner which impedes snow removal.

Any vehicle found parked in violation of the winter parking ordinance may be moved by or under the direction of Francestown Police officers or their designee at the sole expense of the owner of said vehicle.

Any person found in violation of these provisions will be subject to a fine not to exceed \$50.00 U.S. for each violation.

Fire Lane Parking:

It shall be unlawful for the owner of any vehicle or any person having custody or control of any vehicle to park or permit the same to be parked or otherwise obstruct fire lanes or fire turn-around areas in the Town of Francestown. Vehicles found parked in violation of the provision of these regulations may be moved by or under the direction of Francestown Police officers or their designee at the sole expense of the owner of said vehicle.
