Mr. Kunhardt presented a contract for the HVAC and plumbing at the Police Station from Wilder Plumbing and Heating in the amount of \$42,865. The Board agreed to contract and authorized Mr. Kunhardt to execute the contract on behalf of the Board.

The Fire Department submitted nomination papers for the appointment of Forest Fire Wardens. Included were 8 re-appointments and 4 new appointments. The Board agreed to the nominations.

The Board executed proxy vote for the Village Water Company annual meeting.

There was a consensus to renew the Health Trust Medical Insurance which had a 5% increase from last year.

Mr. Pike informed the Board that he would like, with Ms. Dalley, to attend this year's Knowing the Territory class on Monday April 16<sup>th.</sup> The Board agreed to close the office and not have a meeting for that day.

A request for the restoration of involuntarily merged lots was submitted by Norm Makechnie on behalf of Elizabeth Wiederhold. The lot in question is Map 14 Lot 13. Portions of this lot were purchased at different times, but appear to have been drawn together when the Town's tax maps were first issued in
