Chairman Howell called the meeting to order at 5:30 PM.

Barry Wicklow requested a letter from the Board in support of the Piscataguog South Branch Connectivity Project to be sent to NHDES in pursuit of a grant. The Board supports the project and issued the letter.

## **Motion Passes**

The question of what to do with the Town Hall benches was raised again. Money is available from a donation for the complete restoration of two benches. Decision was tabled until Mr. Kunhardt can examine the benches.

The Board reviewed an application for the restoration of involuntarily merged lots, Map 12 Lot 3 owned by Robert Staub. The title chain was clear that the whole of the parcel was purchased from different parties at different times. Ms. Arnold made a motion to approve the application Mr. Howell seconded.

## **Motion Passes**

Gary Paige has requested the Board to create a roadside vegetation control policy. Mr. Pike has begun drafting such and will distribute.

The Board issued a Zoning Violation regarding a junkyard on Map 8 Lot 94.

The Board approved Cher Barker's request to use the horse sheds for the Community Church of Francestown's 'Peace Camp' during the mornings, the week of Aug. 20-24.

The Board approved the dates for the Anti-harassment training provided by Primex for the Town employees and volunteers. Classes will be held August 16<sup>th</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup>. Flyers will be distributed to all pertinent personnel.

Mr. Pike informed the Board that all of the Town Hall warranty issues have been taken care of.

Mr. Paige, Road Agent, submitted an application for tree trimming on two scenic roads, Journeys End and County Rd South which raised the question of finishing the trimming that was done on Old County Rd N. in 2017. Mr. Pike is to look into whether the prison work programs are still available for cleanup.

Mr. Pike would like to start looking for an on call Transfer Station employee and Highway Dept employee.

Mr. Kunhardt gave an update on progress at the PD. Non-essential items will be moved this week. Alan Treadwell will be taking care of Belltronics. Mr. Pike will pick up used desk this week and Chief Douglas is to pick out some chairs.
