- 2. Approval of Nov 4th minutes. Ethel made motion made to approve, Polly second. All in favor.
- 3. Repair of broken cemetery stone in #3. William Hopkins, shattered into 5 parts. The parts are at Kaufholds of Peterborough Marble & Granite. They will put a thin slice of marble on the back and glue the pieces onto it. Estimate is \$175. Ruth made motion to proceed with the repair and payment. Seconded by Polly. All in favor.
