

## **Minutes of Cemetery Commission meeting September 25, 2020**

Meeting commenced 10:35.

Polly Freese, Ethel MacStubbs and Bridget Howell in attendance.

Review of minutes of meeting of September 8, 2020. Need to modify item 5 to omit names and item 1 to correct spelling. Motion to accept as amended by Polly. Seconded by Ethel. Minutes accepted, as amended.

1) Discussion of burial of Louis Edwards' ashes and request of his brother, Bob, to dig the grave himself and put down stone. Lot number is 196. Agreed we tell him Trustees want usual procedure followed of having Dan Keaveny dig grave and the Kaufolds put in stone. Patriot Purposes Committee will get flag out and do modified service on October 10.

2) Cilley funeral. Estimate that 150 people attended . Although family told social distancing and masks needed and there were masks over on table and hand sanitizer, only about one third of people had masks on. Not good social distancing. We will reiterate to next families (Edwards and Jones) the need to adhere to our COVID policy.

3) Bryant Landscaping is hoping to get \$1,000 seeding project done in October.

4) Discussed 2021 budget. Polly moved that for 2021, we keep same budget as in 2020. Motion seconded by Ethel and all agreed.

5) Green burials requested by at least two residents (no date upcoming for burials). Discussion. Agree to postpone decision until further research can be done.
