## **Police Log**

**4/25/2020 – 5/19/2020**

1. On 4/25/2020 at 1029 hours, police responded to a residence on the 2<sup>nd</sup> NH Turnpike (S), regarding online harassment.
2. On 4/26/2020 at 1345 hours, police responded with Fracestown Fire Department, to the transfer station for a small brush fire.
3. On 4/29/20 at 0828 hours, police responded to a residential alarm on Poor Farm Road. Upon arrival, the house was checked and found to be secure.
4. On 4/30/2020 at 1302 hours, Fracestown Police investigated attempted scam phone calls to a resident on Dodge Hill Road.
5. On 5/02/20 at 1131 hours, Fracestown Police investigated a past tense dog bite complaint, occurring on Oak Hill Road.
6. On 5/7/20 at 0837 hours, police investigated a report of online threatening from a resident on Greenfield Road.
7. On 5/8/20 at 1337 hours, Fracestown Police investigated a report of two subjects soliciting in the area along Pleasant Pond Road. The subjects were spoken with, and left town without incident.
8. On 5/12/20 at 1324 hours, police responded to the area of Old County Road (N), for a report of a tree on phone wires. Eversource was notified and responded.
9. On 5/14/2020 at 1442 hours, police responded to a residence on Pleasant Pond Road, to check the welfare of several canines at the home. The dogs were inspected and found to be fine.
10. On 5/12/2020 at 0629 hours, Fracestown Police notified Eversource of a tree on wire along the Greenfield Road. Eversource responded
11. On 5/17/2020 at 1306 hours, police responded to a report of a two motorcycle accident on the New Boston Road. Driver Anhtuan Nguyen, 29 years old of Lynn MA, lost control of his 2019 Kawasaki, veered off the roadway onto the shoulder, and was ejected. This action caused the motorcycle behind him to also lose control and veer off the roadway into the woods, ejecting the operator. This driver, Tung Vu , 47 years old of Dorchester MA, was operating a 2012 Triumph. Mike's Towing responded to the scene and removed both motorcycles. Both operators sustained

injuries and were transported to Monadnock Community Hospital, where they were treated and released.

12. On 5/19/2020 at 0716 hours, Frankestown police investigated a single car rollover accident with injuries on Old County Road (N). The driver, Kyle Shearer, 19 years old, of Peterborough, NH, was driving a 2000 Jeep Cherokee, when he lost control of the vehicle. Shearer suffered a head wound, and was transported via ambulance to Monadnock Community Hospital, where he was treated and released. Mike's Towing removed the vehicle from the scene.
