## **Police Log**

**11/24/2019 – 12/14/2019**

1. On 11/24/2019 at 0711 hours, police responded to the Greenfield Road, for a single car motor vehicle accident. Driver Emelyne Fournier of Greenfield, driving a silver Toyota, had slid off the road into an embankment. There were no injuries. The vehicle was towed from the scene.
