Friday, June 12, 2020  
Emergency Meeting (RSA 91-A:2,II)

Members present: Chairman Henry Kunhardt and Marsha Dixon

Others present: Town Admin. Jamie A Pike, Health Officer Kay Anderson, and Chief Michael Dowd.

This emergency meeting was called by Chairman Kunhardt upon the discovery of a positive case of COVID-19 in Frankestown and to determine the required response regarding the whether to close the Community Market.

Chairman Kunhardt called the meeting to order at 11:00am.

Mr. Kunhardt explained that he had been contacted by Dawn Kirlin who informed him that she had been in contact with a person who had tested positive for COVID-19 and was at the Market on June 5th. She questioned closing the Community Market. It was ultimately decided by Ms. Kirlin to close the market for the 12<sup>th</sup>, self-quarantine and re-open the market on the 19<sup>th</sup>.

Ms. Anderson stated that the market could open following the universal guidelines issued by the Governor.

It was noted that the Governor had also issued guidelines for museums, and Mr. McAuley would be given permission to open under those guidelines on a time frame that would allow them to be put in place.

Chairman Kunhardt adjourned the meeting at 11:30am.
