


- The State EOC will officially close and return to Steady State at 1600.

July 18th NASCAR race in Loudon.




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


NH Weather Snapshot

- 0900 Social media trends:
- Local topics include: The unvaccinated account for 98% of NH COVID deaths since February 1st, NH COVID-19 cases and hospitalizations up slightly, NH health officials praise progress against COVID-19, say there's more to do, Keene's fixed site to have fewer hours as vaccine push pivots to pop-ups, and

county may use COVID stimulus money for state school redevelopment, Londonderry schools to make masks optional.

• National/regional topics include: Fauci warns there may soon be 'two Americas' as divide widens between vaccinated and unvaccinated areas, poll: workers more likely to get vaccinated if employers offer paid time off, heart inflammation after COVID-19 shots higher than expected in study of the US military, Moderna's COVID-19 vaccine shows promise against Delta variant in lab study, what is the Delta variant and should you be concerned, fireworks-related injuries and deaths jumped during the pandemic, health officials search for key to boosting vaccine numbers, virus infections surging in Africa's vulnerable rural areas, Kim berates North Korean officials for 'crucial' virus lapse, and oxygen prices leap in Indonesia's capital as COVID-19 cases surge.
