

## MINUTES

October 14, 2021

The Zoning Board met to consider the application of Chad Mills for a special exception to construct a water impoundment/ agricultural farm pond at 1201 Russell Station Rd., Frankestown NH. Board members present: Sue Jonas, Judi Miller, Scot Heath, Brad Howell and Silas Little. Also present were Ken Robinson of Fieldstone and Mr. and Mrs. Mills for the applicant and Ms. Betsey Hardwick for the Conservation Committee.

Mr. Robinson reviewed the application, its status with NH DES and the request to NRCS, USDA. No response from NRCS has been received. A change in the plans to address NH DES concerns has been made and resubmitted. A copy of the revised plan was given to the Board.

The Board voted for a site walk on the 18<sup>th</sup> October at 9 am. The Board voted to continue the hearing to November 11 at 7 pm in order that the letter from NRCS be received.

No abutters or others opposed. The Conservation Committee submitted a written report and felt if the approval of NH DES was received and the NRCS passed, then the Conservation Commission would be in a position to support the request.
